## POLICE AND FIRE



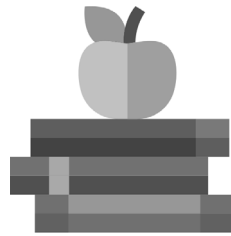

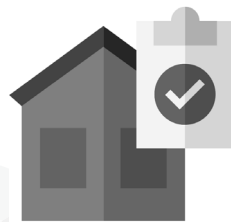
## UTILITIES
